Site safety & important information

Below are some points that you need to know before you attend this year's Festival of Sailing.
Please take the time to read them.

In the 48 hours preceding the event the site team will be busy so if you have any last minute queries or problems about the site, please contact Andrew on [contact info redacted for website](#) – see info email

If you have any safety concerns while on the club site, please report it immediately to the club manager or any UYC official

On arrival you will first unload your boat

- Upon arrival you will remove your boat from its road base and park it on the slipway. Road bases will be stored separately (see map) - then you will be directed to the appropriate camping or parking area.
- Only launching trolleys are allowed on the main lawn or windsurfer lawn.

Camping (tents)

- Only advanced bookings will be allocated space at the event. We expect to be sold out.
- White Boxes (pitches) will be painted on the Birkett field to define individual pitches for bookings with tents. (approx. 8 metres x 5 metres) You may fill this space as you please (tents, gazebos, cars etc - but you must not encroach on the next space or roadways. If your car does not fit inside allocated area with your tent, we will ask you to move it to the carpark. Designated roadways must be kept clear and not used as a car park. **Please see attached map**
- You must display a valid camping permit on the guy line next to your tent door
- One tent one ticket / pitch please
- Please only use gas appliances for cooking – barbecues & open fires are NOT ALLOWED in the camping fields or anywhere onsite.

Campervans & motorhomes (see map)

- Please book and pay in advance – **we cannot guarantee a pitch on the day**
- Follow the directions of the marshals – you will be shown where to park
- Small (VW t5's) campervans will be parked separately to larger motorhomes and tents.
- Permits must be displayed by tying them to the wingmirror of your motorhome
- A 2-metre space will be allocated between vans – Lines will be marked to show where the middle of each Motorhome should sit.
- If you wish to keep a space for another motorhome (friend or family) please ask site staff for a traffic cone and place it on the next centreline along

Open fires and charcoal barbecues

Barbecues and open fires are NOT permitted anywhere on site. The club's barbecues are available for all members and guests to use throughout the event (see map).

Car parking

- Please follow the instructions of the marshals when parking.
- Owners of vehicles parking on the site do so at their own risk. The club cannot accept any liability for damage or theft from vehicles on the site.
- Please always ensure that the site access roads are not obstructed.

Clubhouse

The clubhouse & marquee are provided for the convenience of all members and competitors, who are expected to behave sensibly. Smoking and vaping is not permitted in the clubhouse or marquee. Catering facilities will be notified to competitors separately.

Dogs

Please consider if it is wise for your four-legged friend to join you at this event given that a lot of people will be onsite and the inevitable noise and children enjoying themselves.

Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and are not allowed on the front lawns or in the clubhouse at any time. Owners must ensure that dogs do not foul any part of the club site, or if they do so, the owner of the dog must dispose of such fouling.

Environment

- The club has taps for water around the site (see map).
- An Elsan disposal facility is available near the clubhouse (see map).
- Recycling and waste disposal facilities are provided throughout the site – please follow the instructions on individual bins.

Members Kitchen / Facilities

- A members kitchen is located to the rear of the clubhouse.
- A sink with hot and cold running water is available together with a freezer for cooling ice blocks.
- Please keep this facility clean

First Aid

A dedicated first aid room is located in the managers office – please ask any member of staff for access or an emergency telephone number will be displayed on the door.

Lost & Found

Items misplaced during the event are kept at the Bar.

Insurance

All craft kept or used at the club must carry adequate third-party liability insurance of at least £2m.

Jetties

Two jetties are provided for the benefit of competitors and event support teams. These are often busy places, so please move all boats away from them as soon as possible for the safety and convenience of all users.

Road Speed

A maximum vehicle speed limit of 10mph applies throughout the club site and the adjacent field.
